Introduction

- iii. Scroll down to "Sports".
- iv. Scroll right and click on "Exploits".
- v. On this page, there is a listing of both television and radio broadcasts. Using the list on the backside of this page, you will listen to or watch the clips and complete the chart given. Look carefully through the list of clips to find the correct one.
