

# GUIDELINES FOR THE WRITTEN REPORT

1. The report should be neatly handwritten or typed with no errors.
2. The **cover page** should have a creative title, your name, your partner's name, due date, school name. An interesting drawing about the activity should be coloured using pencil crayons.
3. The **birth certificate, baptismal certificate, and the Health Card** must include the proper identification. They should be creative, coloured and neat. You should have named your child with an interesting name. You should choose godparents.
4. A **sketch** of your egg should be included.
5. The report should include a plan of your **budget**. Your budget should include the cost of start up materials such as:  
*crib, car seat, high chair, stroller, baby monitor, baby bottles, toys, blankets, change table, mobile, night light, bib, baby bath, play pen, jolly jumper, walker,*  
It should also include a monthly plan that includes:  
*food, clothing, diapers (washable or disposable), medical fees, scholarship fund and any miscellaneous expenses.*  
Items listed in your budget should be cut out from flyers and catalogues. The picture and the price should be included.
6. A **supervision schedule** that covers every minute of the seven days. Partners should have an equal share of the responsibility.
7. Finally a **written essay** of how the week went. It should be in proper paragraphs and should answer these questions (do not write out the questions):
  - a. What difficulties and problems did you and your partner have? How were they solved?
  - \* b. What was the most difficult aspect of this activity? What was the easiest aspect?
  - c. Explain the things you enjoyed and the things you did not enjoy.
  - \* d. What is difficult about being a parent?
  - \* e. What did you learn about being a parent that you did not know before?
  - f. After completing this game, would you still want to be a parent some day?
